

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC BY THE COUNTY OF ALAMOSA, STATE OF COLORADO; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1995 EDITION OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES;" REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Title 30, Article 15, Part 4; and Title 42, Article 4, C.R.S. 1973 as amended, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to adopt ordinances to control and regulate the movement and parking of motor vehicles on public property; and

WHEREAS, Title 18, Article 4, Section 511, C.R.S., as amended, authorizes the control of littering on public and private property; and

WHEREAS, Title 30, Article 15, Section 402, C.R.S., as amended, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to execute the penalty assessment procedure provided in §16-2-201, C.R.S. as amended, and to adopt a graduated fine schedule for violations of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a public meeting on this resolution for a first reading on July 1, 1998, and a second reading on July 29, 1998, and adoption on August 12, 1998, and have considered testimony and evidence presented at the meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ALAMOSA, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of the Model Traffic Code. There is hereby adopted by reference Articles I to II, inclusive, of the 1995 revised edition of the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities," promulgated and published as such by the Colorado Department of Transportation. The subject matter of the Model Traffic Code related primarily to comprehensive traffic control regulations for the County of Alamosa. The purpose of this Ordinance and the Code adopted herein is to provide a system of traffic regulations consistent with state law and generally conforming to similar regulations throughout the state and the nation. Three (3) copies of the Model Traffic Code adopted herein shall be filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder of Alamosa County, Colorado, and may be inspected during regular business hours.

Section 2. Deletions. The 1995 edition of the Model Traffic Code is adopted as if set out at length save and except for the following section which is declared to be inapplicable to this County and are therefore expressly deleted: None.

Section 3. Additions and Modifications to the Model Traffic Code. The adopted Code is subject to the following additions and modifications:

(a) This ordinance shall be known as and referred to as the "Alamosa County Traffic Code."

(b) Wherever the Model Traffic Code refers to the jurisdiction adopting the Code with the words "municipality" there shall be substituted the words "this County."

(c) Wherever the Model Traffic Code refers to the "chief of police" and the "police department," there shall be substituted the words "Alamosa County Sheriff" and "Sheriff's Office," respectively.

Section 4. Penalties. The following penalties, herewith set forth in full, shall apply to this ordinance:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions adopted in this ordinance.

(b) Every person convicted of a violation of any provision adopted in this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, unless a specific penalty is provided in Section 5, herein.

Section 5. Penalty Assessment Procedure and Penalty Schedule. The penalty schedule set forth below shall apply whether the violator is issued a penalty assessment notice or a summons and complaint. The penalties for violating specific sections of this Traffic Code shall be as follows:

Section 5.1. Traffic Fine Schedule. See attached Exhibit A.

Section 5.2. Penalty Assessment Procedure. Points assessed for any violation of the provisions stated or adopted in or by this ordinance shall be reduced as follows if the penalty assessment and surcharge is paid within twenty days of the date of the penalty assessment notice or summons and complaint: a six point violation shall be reduced to a three point violation; a four point violation shall be reduced to a two point violation; a three point violation shall be reduced to a two point violation; and a two point violation shall be reduced to a one point violation. If the penalty assessment and surcharge is not paid within the time provided in this section 5.2 and the alleged offender is found guilty, court costs of \$18.00 shall be assessed in addition to the fine and surcharge. Said surcharge shall be used to assist the Alamosa County Sheriff's Office Victim Advocate and Officer Training Programs.

Section 6. Application. This ordinance shall apply to every street, alley, sidewalk area, driveway, park, and every other public way or public place or public parking area, either within or outside the corporate limits of this County, the use of which this County has jurisdiction and authority to regulate. The provisions of sections 1401, 1402, 1413, and part 16 of the adopted Model Traffic Code, respectively concerning reckless driving, careless driving, eluding a police officer, and accidents and accident reports shall apply not only to public places and ways but also throughout this County.

Section 7. Disposition of Fines and Forfeitures. All fines and forfeitures for the violation of this ordinance shall be paid into the treasury of the Alamosa County general fund.

Section 8. Validity. If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of County Commissioners hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared invalid.

Section 9. Repeal. Existing or parts of existing ordinances or resolutions covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance or resolution hereby repealed prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 10. Interpretation. This ordinance shall be so interpreted and construed as to effectuate its general purpose to conform with the State's uniform system for the regulation of vehicles and traffic. Article and section headings of the ordinance and adopted Model Traffic Code shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or extent of the provisions of any article or section thereof.

Section 11. Certification. The County Clerk and Recorder shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and make not less than three copies of the adopted Code available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.

Section 12. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective thirty days after final publication subsequent to the adoption on a second reading.


